

## Miami spot a contender in reality show

Spoiler alert: Miami Beach's Dolce Italian emerged victorious in the first round of Best New Restaurant, Bravo TV's new head-to-head reality food competition that premiered Wednesday night. Chefs Paolo Dorigato, Renato Viola, front-of-house guy Dean Tsakanikas and crew bested the team from Beverly Hills hot spot Doma in a battle of Italian eateries.

Dolce will now chill mostly off-air for a few episodes while four other Miami restaurants — The Federal, Tongue & Cheek, Buns & Buns and R House — star in upcoming challenges. Up next: The Federal, which competes against Austin, Texas, gastropub next week when Best New Restaurant returns at 10 p.m. Wednesday.

In each episode, host/judge Tom Colicchio (who is opening Beachcraft this year in Miami Beach) declares a winner after observing how the restaurants handle a packed house, VIPs and undercover diners.
