

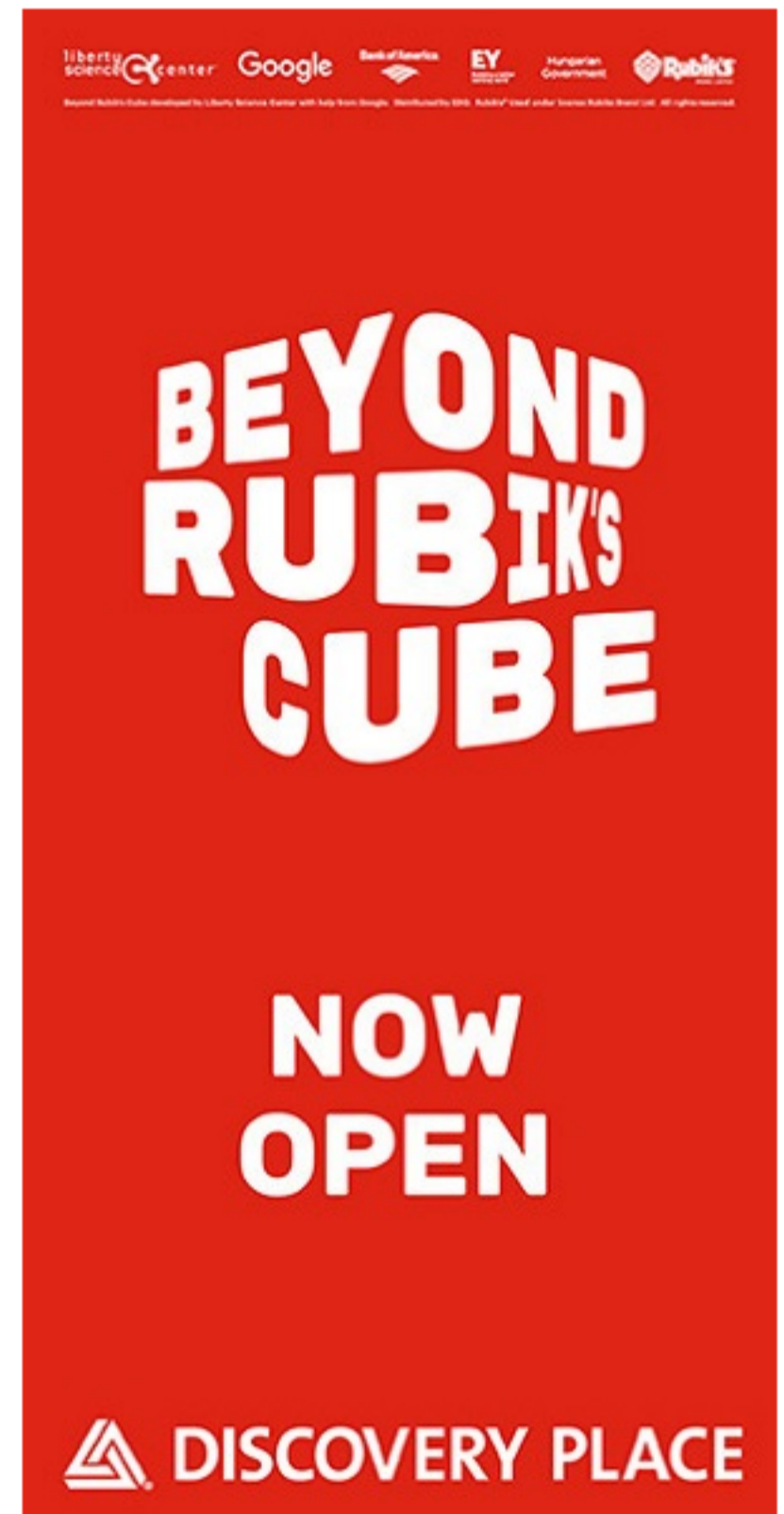

Justin Jedlica, who grew up in Cary and graduated from Apex High, looks for love on the debut of WeTV's "Million Dollar Matchmaker." WE tv



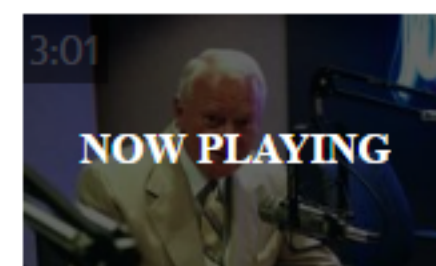

Million Dollar Matchmaker (10 p.m., WeTV) - Formerly Bravo's "Millionaire Matchmaker," Patti Stanger has taken her show to WeTV, still trying to match highly coached single people with eligible millionaires. Tonight's debut features Justin Jedlica, who grew up in Cary and graduated from Apex High School. Justin, who now lives in Los Angeles and works in "plastic surgery consulting," calls himself "The Human Ken Doll" and here's why: he's had 288 plastic surgery procedures and has more planned. He tells Patti that he has the surgeries because he loves getting attention. Of Justin, Patti says, "I've never seen a tougher case than this."
